# The Details

**WHERE:** Home of Betty Bella & Ralphie (Bubbe's granddaughter and grandson-in-law) because they're on good terms with everyone in the family, including Mrs. Farbergoldstein & Bookie.

**WHEN:** Any Thursday evening (nobody thinks you're rude if you leave early, and nobody minds if you stay late, because it's only a day to the weekend).

**WHY:** Bubbe and Zaide have a home in Vancouver, and now one in Palm Springs, but there are those in our community who have no shelter at all. Bubbe and Zaide have family who love them and will help them no matter what, but some people in our community have no one to turn to. They struggle every day, for food and clothing, to overcome mental health issues, to make new lives in Canada.

By staying home to say good-bye to Bubbe rather than going out to eat, you support people in our community who need your help today.
